

LANDS FOR RAILROAD.

RESOLUTION

OF THE

LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS,

ASKING

For a grant of land for the construction of a railroad from Fulton to the Missouri line.

JANUARY 15, 1859.—Ordered to be printed.

Resolved, That our senators be instructed and our representatives in Congress be requested to use their best exertions to procure a grant of lands to construct a railroad from Fulton, on Red river, *via* Fort Smith, Van Buren, Fayetteville, and Bentonville, to the Missouri line, in the direction of Springfield, in Missouri, or some suitable point near the western boundary of the State of Missouri.
