SIR: In compliance with a resolution of the House of Representatives of January 30, 1882, I have the honor to transmit herewith a table containing lists of all resignations, removals, promotions, and appointments, under the grade of Assistant Postmaster-General, made in this department since the 4th day of March, 1881, of persons employed in the post-office service in the city of Washington, excluding mail-carriers, and including inspectors.

The table will show whether the resignations were voluntary or upon request. In the two cases in which the table shows the resignations were by request, there is no record of the reasons for such request. I am therefore unable to furnish any information upon that subject.

In cases of removal, the table will indicate, so far as there is any record of the same in this department, what were the reasons for such removals.

In appointments, the grade, the residence of each appointee, the recommendation and influence under which each appointment was made are given.

Promotions, so far as I have been able to learn, have been uniformly made with regard to the merit and capacity of the employé, and not so much with regard to length of service. All candidates for promotion or appointment to positions above the grade of a thousand dollars have been examined by a board to ascertain their qualifications. In several instances these examinations have been competitive.

The table will also show the appointments made upon the "temporary roll," and upon whose recommendation, so far as can be ascertained, such appointments were made.
