BRIDGE ACROSS PEA RIVER AT ELBA, ALA.

Mr. BINGHAM, from the Committee on Commerce, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H. R. 8527]

The Committee on Commerce, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 8527) granting the consent of Congress to the highway department of the State of Alabama to construct a bridge across Pea River at Elba, Coffee County, Ala., have considered the same and report thereon with an amendment, and as so amended, recommend that the bill do pass.

Amend the bill as follows:

In line 2, page 2, strike out the period, insert a colon, and add the following:

Provided, That such bridge shall not be constructed or commenced until the plans and specifications thereof shall have been submitted to and approved by the Secretary of War and the Chief of Engineers as being also satisfactory from the standpoint of the volume and weight of the traffic which will pass over it.

The bill has the approval of the Departments of War and Agriculture.
