Mr. REECE, from the Committee on Military Affairs, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H. J. Res. 226]

The Committee on Military Affairs, to which was referred the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 226) authorizing the Secretary of War to lend 350 cots, 350 bed sacks, and 700 blankets for the use of the National Custer Memorial Association, at Crow Agency, Mont., at the semicentennial of the Battle of the Little Big Horn, June 24, 25, and 26, 1926, having considered the same, report thereon with the recommendation that it do pass with the following amendment:

Page 1, line 5, strike out the words "at the" and insert the words "for use in connection with."

Page 1, line 7, strike out the words "three hundred and fifty cots, three hundred" and the words "and fifty bed sacks, and seven hundred blankets" on line 8, and insert in lieu thereof the words "such tents and other equipment as may be required at said semicentennial." Amend the title to read as follows:

Authorizing the Secretary of War to lend tents and camp equipment for the use of the National Custer Memorial Association, at Crow Agency, Mont., at the semicentennial of the Battle of the Little Big Horn, June 24, 25, and 26, 1926.

This is a measure to permit the Secretary of War to loan to veterans of Indian wars certain tents and other equipment needed for their gathering in Montana in June of this year. As amended, it is in the usual form carrying provisos for the protection of the Government in the matter of the return of the property in good condition.
