Mr. PARKS, from the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany S. 3195]

The Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce, to whom was referred the bill (S. 3195) granting the consent of Congress to the highway department of the State of Tennessee to construct a bridge across the Tennessee River on the Lenoir City-Sweetwater Road, in Loudon County, Tenn., having considered the same, report thereon with amendment and, as amended, recommend that it pass.

Amend the bill as follows:

Line 7, page 1, strike out "Lenior City-" and insert "Lee Highway."

Line 8, page 1, strike out "Sweetwater Road" and insert "at Loudon."

Line 1, page 2, change the colon to a period and strike out the balance of the line.

Strike out lines 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, page 2.

Amend the title so as to read:

Granting the consent of Congress to the highway department of the State of Tennessee to construct a bridge across the Tennessee River on the Lee Highway at Loudon, in Loudon County, Tennessee.
