R E P O R T

[To accompany H. J. Res. 318]

The Committee on Military Affairs, to whom was referred H. J. Res. 318, a joint resolution to authorize the Secretary of War to lend tentage, cots, and blankets for the use of the Virginia Department of the Veterans of Foreign Wars at its annual encampment, June, 1927, having considered the same, report favorably thereon with the recommendation that it do pass.

This is a bill drawn in the usual form authorizing the Secretary of War to loan to the Veterans of Foreign Wars certain tents, cots, and blankets for use at an annual encampment of the Virginia Department at Purcellville, Va., June 27, 28, and 29, 1927. The resolution has the usual proviso safeguarding the War Department against loss.
