SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "United States Commission on
Civil Rights Authorization Act of 1992".

SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION.

Section 7 of the United States Commission on Civil Rights
Act of 1983 (42 U.S.C. 1975e) is amended by adding at the end
the following: "There are authorized to be appropriated to carry
out this Act \$7,422,014 for fiscal year 1993, and an additional
\$850,000 for fiscal year 1993 to relocate the headquarters office.
None of the sums authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year
1993 may be used to create additional regional offices."
