Res. 295.

Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring), That section 3 of the concurrent resolution entitled "Concurrent resolution to establish a joint congressional committee to be known as the Joint Committee on Housing" (H. Con. Res. 104, Eightieth Congress), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 3. The committee shall report to the Senate and the House of Representatives not later than March 15, 1948, the results of its study and investigation, together with such recommendations as to necessary legislation and such other recommendations as it may deem advisable. For administrative purposes of concluding its business the committee is authorized to continue until May 15, 1948."
