ORDER

On December 6, 2021, United States Magistrate Judge Patricia Harris entered an order informing Mr. Gilliam that he must file an amended complaint within 30 days.¹ Mr. Longstreath was warned that his complaint may be dismissed if he did not file an amended complaint.
