Before **KELLY, MURPHY** and **McCONNELL**, Circuit Judges.

This matter is before the court on the “Agreed Motion to Lift Stay and Remand Case to District Court for Further Proceedings” (“Motion”) filed jointly by the parties. The parties agree that the decision of this court in Wrenn v. Astrue, 525 F.3d 931 (10th Cir. 2008), has an impact on this case and that the district court should accordingly have the opportunity to reconsider its judgment.

The Motion is granted. The abatement previously ordered in this appeal is lifted. The judgment order of the district court being appealed is vacated. The case is remanded to the district court for further consideration in light of the Wrenn decision. The mandate
