ORDER

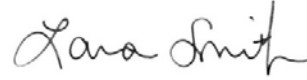
On June 12, 2018, Petitioner Tu My Tong was advised that the mandamus petition submitted that day was incomplete and must be supplemented. The filing fees were not paid when the petition was filed, and the petition did not include a compliant certificate of service. The court granted Tong until July 12, 2018, to remedy the deficiencies.

The court's June 12, 2018 order directing Tong to supplement the petition was returned to the court as undeliverable. No forwarding information was provided by the postal service. The deadline to supplement the petition has passed. Tong has not communicated with the court to provide current mailing information or to file a supplement to the petition.

It is Tong's burden to keep the court informed of a current mailing address. *See* 10th Cir. R. 46.1(C); *see also* 10th Cir. R. 46.5(A) (requiring all filings to state the signer's mailing address, email address and telephone number). The fact that Tong is proceeding pro se does not eliminate this burden. *Theede v. U.S. Dep't of Labor*, 172 F.3d 1262, 1267 (10th Cir. 1999).

In light of the foregoing, this mandamus is dismissed for lack of prosecution. 10th
Cir. R. 42.1. A copy of this order shall stand as and for the mandate of the court.
