ORDER

Before **TYMKOVICH**, Chief Judge, **BRISCOE** and **EID**, Circuit Judges.

The order being appealed is not final or immediately appealable as all of the claims against all of the parties have not been fully adjudicated in the district court. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1291; Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b). On January 9, 2019, this court entered an order giving the plaintiff 30 days in which to obtain a Rule 54(b) certification from the district court. *See Lewis v. B.F. Goodrich Co.*, 850 F.2d 641, 645-46 (10th Cir. 1988). He has failed to do so, and has not requested such a certification from the district court.

Accordingly, because all of the claims against all of the parties have not been resolved in the district court, this court lacks jurisdiction. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b).

APPEAL DISMISSED. This order does not preclude the plaintiff from filing a timely appeal after entry of final judgment.
