We raise *sua sponte* the question of whether this court has jurisdiction to consider this appeal. Martin S. Gottesfeld, proceeding pro se, filed a notice of appeal of the magistrate judge's July 12, 2019 minute order denying Mr. Gottesfeld's motion to intervene.

An order entered by a magistrate judge is not directly appealable to this court unless the magistrate judge was proceeding on a designation by the district court and with the consent of the parties under 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). See Phillips v. Beierwaltes, 466 F.3d

1217, 1220-21 (10th Cir. 2006); Colo. Bldg. & Constr. Trades Council v. B.B. Andersen Constr. Co., 879 F.2d 809, 811 (10th Cir. 1989).

Accordingly, we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal.
