ORDER

On December 4, 2019, this court held that the Prison Litigation Reform Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g), applies to this appeal; ordered Terrance D. Godfrey to pay the full \$505.00 appellate filing fee to the district court on or before December 26, 2019; and advised Mr. Godfrey that, if the district court did not receive timely payment in full of the appellate filing fee, this court would dismiss his appeal for lack of prosecution. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g); 10th Cir.
