ORDER

Before **BACHARACH, PHILLIPS, and McHUGH**, Circuit Judges.

This matter is before the court on a petition for permission to appeal filed by Plaintiffs in the above-captioned district court case. Plaintiffs request permission to appeal, pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 5 and Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(f), the district court's October 5, 2022 order denying class certification. Defendants filed a response opposing the motion.

Upon careful consideration, Plaintiffs' petition for permission to appeal is GRANTED. *See Vallario v. Vandehey*, 554 F.3d 1259, 1262 (10th Cir. 2009) (appellate

courts have discretionary power to permit interlocutory appeals of class certification orders). Within 14 days from the date of this order, Plaintiffs shall pay the \$505.00 filing and docketing fee to the Clerk of the U.S. District Court for the District of Wyoming. *See* Fed. R. App. P. 5(d)(1)(A). The date of this order shall serve as the date of the notice of appeal. *Id.* at 5(d)(2). The Clerk of this court is directed to open a new appeal once the clerk of the district court notifies this court that the filing fee has been paid. *Id.* at 5(d)(3).

Once the new appeal has been opened, it will proceed in the usual course, in accordance with the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and this court's local rules.
