ORDER

This matter is before the court on: (1) Corizon, LLC’s April 28, 2025 *Updated Bankruptcy Status Report*, in which it states that it “has been released from this and all Causes of Action as set forth in Article IX.E of the Plan” and submits that “[t]his appeal . . . should be dismissed” [CTA10 Dkt. No. 112-1]; and (2) plaintiffs-appellants response in which they “agree that Debtor Corizon has been released from this cause of action

pursuant to the Chapter 11 Plan that became effective on March 31, 2025” [CTA10 Dkt. No. 114].

Upon consideration, the court:

- A. Construes these documents together as a stipulated motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal pursuant to Rule 42(b)(1) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure;
- B. Grants the motion as construed; and
- C. Dismisses this appeal, each party to bear his or its own costs on appeal.
