ORDER

Before **HOLMES**, Chief Judge, **BACHARACH** and **PHILLIPS**, Circuit Judges.

David Webb filed a petition for a writ of mandamus, which we construed as seeking, among other forms of relief, an order from this court directing the district court to complete the restricted-filer screening process for a complaint he attempted to file in January 2022. On September 26, 2022, we denied mandamus on his other requests for relief and invited the district court to respond to this portion of the petition. On September 27, the magistrate judge entered an order recommending that Mr. Webb's complaint be returned to him unfiled. On October 25, the Chief Judge entered an order concurring with the magistrate judge's reasoning and conclusion. Because the district court has completed the restricted-filer screening process, we deny the remaining portion of Mr. Webb's mandamus petition as moot.
