ORDER

This matter is before the court on appellant GEICO Insurance Agency, LLC's renewed *Motion to Dismiss Cross-Appeal*. GEICO asks the court to (1) dismiss this appeal under Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 42 and (2) tax costs (in the amount of \$605) against appellee Sina Davani.
