ORDER

Before **HARTZ**, **MORITZ**, and **FEDERICO**, Circuit Judges.

This matter is before us on Plaintiff Daniel Lopez's *Petition for Permission to Appeal Class Certification Order Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(f)* and on Defendant Marriott International's *Response in Opposition* thereto.

Upon consideration, the petition for permission to appeal is granted. **Within 14 days** from the date of this order, Mr. Lopez shall pay the \$605.00 filing and docketing fees to the Clerk of the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado. *See* Fed. R. App. P. 5(d)(1)(A). The date of this order shall serve as the date of the notice of appeal. *Id.* at 5(d)(2). The Clerk of this court is directed to open a new appeal once the clerk of the district court notifies this court that the filing and docketing fees have been paid. *Id.* at 5(d)(3).

Once the new appeal has been opened, it will proceed in the normal course, in accordance with the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and this court's local rules.
