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OPINION

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PER CURIAM

Pro se litigant Harvey Patrick Short has petitioned this Court for a writ of mandamus directing the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey to conduct an “initial review” of his second amended complaint, and “to allow the action to proceed with [service of process] if a cause of action is established . . . .” The District
