PER CURIAM:

Stanford El Christopher McPherson, Jr., appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2006). Accordingly, we deny McPherson's motion for appointment of counsel and dismiss the appeal for the reasons stated by the district court. McPherson v.
