PER CURIAM:

Harrison Lewis, III, petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his civil suit. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Accordingly, because the district court has recently decided Lewis' case, we deny the mandamus petition as moot. We grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
