PER CURIAM:

Monika Ahmadpour-Bahnamiri appeals the district court's order dismissing with prejudice her amended complaint filed pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, 42 U.S.C.A. § 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 2012 & Supp. 2018).
