PER CURIAM:

Ryan Anderson appeals the district court's order dismissing his in forma pauperis complaint as frivolous, vexatious, and for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny the motion to appoint counsel and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *See Anderson v.
