PER CURIAM:

Darlene M. Bloch appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment in favor of TransAmerica. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Bloch v. TransAmerica Premier Life Ins. Co.*, No. 2:18-cv-00660-RBS-DEM (E.D. Va. July 19, 2019). In addition, we decline to consider issues raised for the first time on appeal. *See Muth v. United States*, 1 F.3d 246, 250 (4th Cir. 1993).
