Alan Wade Johnson, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing his complaint against prison officials under the Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1346(b), 2671-80 (2012).
