PER CURIAM:

Porsha Ramseur appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment in favor of Concentrix CVG Customer Management Group Inc., on Ramseur's religious discrimination claims, brought pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *See Ramseur v. Concentrix CVG Customer Mgmt. Grp.
