PER CURIAM:

Tyrone Shelton appeals the district court's order dismissing, after a review pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, Shelton's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action alleging he was denied adequate medical care for a serious medical need while housed at Lunenburg Correctional Center. We have reviewed the record and find no error. We therefore affirm the district court's judgment. *Shelton v. Iqbal*, No. 1:21-cv-00032-CMH-TCB (E.D. Va. Feb. 8, 2021).
