PER CURIAM:

James Lee Cecil, Jr., appeals the district court's order granting Defendants summary judgment in Cecil's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 civil rights action. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *Cecil v. Bowman*, No. 7:20-cv-00349-EKD-JCH (W.D. Va. June 22, 2023).
