PER CURIAM:

Angela J. Dwyer appeals the district court's orders denying her motion to remand and granting Defendant's motion to dismiss Dwyer's complaint alleging race discrimination and retaliation claims, brought pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17.
