PER CURIAM:

Adonnis R. Shephard, Sr., appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on Shephard's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Appellee Searls's motion to strike Shephard's reply brief, deny Shephard's motion to appoint counsel, and affirm the district court's order. *Shephard v.
