PER CURIAM:

Christopher Allen Dontell appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and granting summary judgment for Appellees on Dontell's deliberate indifference, failure to protect, retaliation, and equal protection claims asserted in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint.
