PER CURIAM:

Ogungbemi Omojola David Yewande appeals the district court's order dismissing his complaint without prejudice under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m) for failure to effect service. We have reviewed the record and discern no abuse of discretion in the district court's decision. *See Attkisson v. Holder*, 925 F.3d 606, 627 (4th Cir. 2019) (providing standard of review).
