PER CURIAM:

Jerome Andrew Burnett appeals the district court's orders (1) sua sponte dismissing his complaint alleging violations of his civil and constitutional rights, and denying as moot his motion to proceed in forma pauperis; and (2) denying reconsideration of the dismissal order.
