PER CURIAM:

Qian Williams appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on Williams's complaint under *Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Federal Bureau of Narcotics*, 403 U.S. 388 (1971), and the Federal Tort Claims Act. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
