The attorney appointed to represent Chisanga Mable Scott has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Scott has filed a response and moved for the appointment of
