PER CURIAM.

Derrick Kim Patterson appeals his conviction for possession with intent to distribute cocaine base. He argues that the district court¹ abused its discretion in restricting cross-examination of the informant who testified against him. Having carefully reviewed the record and applicable law in this case, this court concludes that, even if there were error, it was harmless in light of the overwhelming evidence supporting the conviction.
