PER CURIAM.

Robert Love, who has been committed under Missouri's Sexually Violent Predator Act, appeals the district court's¹ 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) preservice dismissal without prejudice of his complaint. Following de novo review, see Moore v. Sims, 200 F.3d 1170, 1171 (8th Cir. 2000) (per curiam), we conclude the district court properly dismissed the complaint. Among its infirmities, the complaint did not specify which of the many named defendants was responsible for each of the alleged harms, many of the claims were stated in the most general terms, and the attack on the fact and duration of Love's confinement must be brought in a habeas corpus petition after exhausting state remedies.

Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
