PER CURIAM.

Frederick Lee Pitchford appeals the district court's¹ dismissal of his employment discrimination complaint. Pitchford's only argument in his brief on appeal is that the district court lacked jurisdiction to rule on the motion to dismiss, because he failed to pay the filing fee below. This argument fails. *See Rodgers ex rel.*

Jones v. Bowen, 790 F.2d 1550, 1552 (11th Cir. 1986) (noting that court had expressly rejected theory that timely payment of filing fee is jurisdictional requirement).
