The parties to this action, JAMES P. CHANDLER and NAHUM D. CHANDLER, plaintiffs, and MAXINE I. MAYS, by and through their counsel of record, hereby execute this Joint Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice on the following terms and conditions:

1. WHEREAS, James P. Chandler and Nahum D. Chandler filed suit against Maxine I. Mays in United States District Court for the Central District of California, Case No.1:07-CV-

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2 00210AWI-TAG and Maxine I. Mays has brought counterclaims and other affirmative claims
3 against James P. Chandler and Nahum D. Chandler in Case No.1:07-CV-00210AWI-TAG
4 (Case No. 1:07-CV-00210AWI-TAG is referred to hereinafter as the "Federal Action"); and
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6 2. WHEREAS, the Parties wish to resolve their disputes, including all claims brought by
7 the Parties in the Federal Action;

8 3. NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained in a
9 settlement agreement signed by the parties and other good and valuable consideration, the
10 receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties, by and through their
11 counsel, stipulate:

12 a. The quiet title order should vest title in the following named individuals: James P.
13 Chandler, Juanita Phillips, Edith Sellers, Mildred Sumlin, Rebekah Benjamin, Arnold L.
14 Chandler, Timothy A. Chandler, Wil N. Chandler, Alice P. Johnson, Clarissa Lillie Mae
15 Chandler, and Nahum D. Chandler, as tenants in common, to the following parcels: Parcel 1,
16 Assessor's Parcel Number 172-060-04, together with and including a right of way from
17 Cottonwood Road to the interior of said parcel, more particularly described in Exhibit A hereof,
18 which is incorporated by reference in this stipulation and order, being the same parcel
19 conveyed by John Everett Crown and Helen Crown to J.A. Harris and Idonia Harris, Robert C.
20 Mays and Maxine Mays, and Isaac Chandler and Lillie Mae Chandler in a certain grant deed
21 recorded March 9, 1960 in the Kern County Recorder's Office, Bakersfield, California, Book
22 3246 Page 778, and Parcel 2, part and parcel to a well site of at least twenty five feet square
23 located on Lot 28 of Section 16, Township 30 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Meridian,
24 including access road right of way from Cottonwood Road to said well site of approximately
25 300 feet long and 60 feet wide further described in Exhibit A , and more particularly described
26 in a deed from J.A. Harris and Idonia Harris, Robert C. Mays and Maxine Mays, and Isaac
27 Chandler and Lillie Mae Chandler to Robert Mays and Maxine Mays and Isaac Chandler and
28 Lillie Mae Chandler, Book 3305 Page 68 recorded in Official Records of Kern County,
California, on September 22, 1960.

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3 b. That plaintiffs' claim for quiet title should be granted and that all remaining claims
4 and counterclaims should be dismissed with prejudice.
