ORDER

IT IS HEREBY stipulated between the United States of America through its
undersigned counsel, JASON HITT, Assistant United States Attorney, together with the
defendant, JESUS GAMBOA-MEZA and his counsel NICHOLAS F. REYES, that the
hearing currently scheduled for April 11, 2013 be continued to May 2, 2013 at 9:00a.m.
for anticipation of entry of plea.

25 The parties acknowledge that the time under the Speedy Trial Act is being
26 excluded under Title 18, United States Code, Section 3161 (h)(1)(D); Title 18, United
27 States Code 3161 (h)(7)(A) and Local Code T4 based on necessary delay in perfecting
28 and finalizing the negotiated plea agreement between the government and defendant; and,
the period of delay is jointly requested based on good cause and agreement to finalize the

1 plea agreement for entry of plea at the next scheduled appearance and such delay is
2 necessary as the ends of justice served taken by such action outweigh the best interests of
3 the public and the defendant in a speedy trial.
