2. David Sisson, Stacy Sisson and Lauren Sisson are HELD IN DEFAULT;


3. A judgment by default is HEREBY ENTERED against any right, title, or interests of David Sisson, Stacy Sisson and Lauren Sisson in the Defendant Currency referenced in the above caption;

4. A final judgment of forfeiture is HEREBY ENTERED, forfeiting all right, title, and interest in the Defendant Currency to the United States, to be disposed of according to law; and

5. All parties shall bear their own costs and attorney's fees.
