**ORDER SETTING BRIEFING  
SCHEDULE**

18 Plaintiffs have filed a motion to modify the Court's population reduction order and have  
19 requested an expedited briefing schedule. ECF No. 3219/6522 at 5.<sup>1</sup> Plaintiffs have also  
20 "waive[d] any right to file a reply." *Id.*

21 The Court finds good cause to set the following expedited schedule:<sup>2</sup>

22 1. Defendants' opposition or statement of non-opposition to Plaintiffs' motion shall be  
23 filed no later than March 30, 2020.

1           2. The Court will conduct a telephonic hearing on April 1, 2020, at 1:15 p.m. Dial-in  
2 information will be provided by Judge Tigar's courtroom deputy, who can be reached at  
3 jstcrd@cand.uscourts.gov.

4           3. As a courtesy, the Clerk is directed to send a copy of this order to counsel for former  
5 intervenors in both cases captioned above.<sup>3</sup> Any motions to intervene, accompanied by briefs in  
6 support of or in opposition to Plaintiffs' motion, shall be filed no later than March 30, 2020. *See*  
7 18 U.S.C. § 3626(a)(3)(F). Potential intervenors' briefs in support of or in opposition to the  
8 motion may not exceed 10 pages. Where possible, potential intervenors shall coordinate responses  
9 to avoid duplicative briefing. Oppositions to the motions to intervene or to the arguments of  
10 potential intervenors may be presented at the hearing.


11           4. All briefing deadlines in this order occur at 12:00 noon.
