
24 1. This Court granted Contra Costa County intervening party status on September 19,
25 2007, for purposes of opposing the issuance of a prisoner release order under
26 consideration by this court pursuant to the Prison Litigation Reform Act, 18 U.S.C.
27 3626 *et seq.*; and,

- 1 2. Contra Costa County appeared at the September 24, 2007, hearing conducted by the
- 2 Court and has evaluated whether continued participation as an Intervenor is
- 3 necessary or appropriate given the current posture of the case and the presence of
- 4 numerous other "statutory intervenors."
- 5 3. Contra Costa County believes that if it has information relevant to the Court's
- 6 consideration of a Prisoner Release Order, both the Court's and the County's interest
- 7 would be sufficiently served by participating as *amicus curiae*; and,
- 8 4. Contra Costa County has contacted legal counsel for Plaintiffs, Defendants, and all
- 9 parties designated as Intervenors as of October 25, 2007, to obtain consent to its
- 10 withdrawal; and,
- 11 5. Plaintiffs, Defendants and Intervenors have stipulated to dismissing Contra Costa
- 12 County as an Intervenor in the proceedings now before this Court; and,
- 13 6. Contra Costa County requests this Court order Contra Costa County be dismissed,
- 14 without prejudice, as an Intervenor in CIV S-90-0520 LKK JFM P and No. C01-1351
- 15 TEH, as those cases are now pending before this Court.
