20 **STIPULATION AND ORDER RE:**
RETURN OF TWENTY MENTAL
HEALTH CRISIS BEDS AT CALIFORNIA
MEDICAL FACILITY TO ACUTE
PSYCHIATRIC PROGRAM BEDS

21 The parties to the above-captioned case, through their counsel, stipulate as follows:

22 1. In 2007, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and the
23 Department of State Hospitals converted twenty Acute Psychiatric Program beds located in the S-
24 2 unit of the Vacaville Psychiatric Program at California Medical Facility into temporary Mental
25 Health Crisis Beds.

26 2. Due to an increased need for additional Acute Psychiatric Program beds within the
27 prison system, the parties have agreed to return the twenty temporary Mental Health Crisis Beds
28 to Acute Psychiatric Program beds. Also, the parties have consulted with the *Coleman* Special
Master on this issue, and he approves of the stipulation.
