29 On March 19, 1996, the District Court established procedures by which plaintiffs
30 are to collect periodic attorneys' fees and costs in this case in connection with their work
31 monitoring defendants' compliance with the Court's Orders and collecting fees.

1 Pursuant to these procedures, the parties met and conferred during June 2006
2 concerning outstanding disputed fees and costs incurred by plaintiffs' attorneys during
3 various quarters in the last two years in the category of classification issues. There has
4 been a dispute between the parties over whether any or all of these fees and costs are
5 properly sought by plaintiffs' counsel in this case. Although this dispute has not been
6 resolved definitively by the parties with respect to future fees and costs in this area, the
7 parties have agreed to a compromise concerning the outstanding past disputed fees and
8 costs. Under the compromise, the parties have agreed to payment in this case by
9 defendants of fifty-eight percent (58%) of the classification fees billed by plaintiffs. This
10 resolves all disputed fees and costs through the Fourth Quarter of 2005. Attached hereto
11 as Exhibit A are charts setting forth the fees and expenses now due and owing.

12 THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY STIPULATE AND AGREE that
13 \$46,552.30 plus interest is due and collectable as of 45 days from the date of entry of this
14 order. Daily interest runs from June 30, 2005 at the rate provided by 28 U.S.C. § 1961.
