17 Defendant Eric Paul Jamvold, by and through his counsel of record, hereby requests that  
18 the Court authorize him to travel to Ireland and Scotland from June 22, 2017, to July 6, 2017.

19 Mr. Jamvold has been on supervised probation since his release from imprisonment in  
20 June 2016. Per the conditions of his probation, he participated in an inpatient substance abuse  
21 treatment program following his release from imprisonment. Since completing the treatment  
22 program, Mr. Jamvold has regularly attended Alcoholics Anonymous meetings and has passed  
23 all drug and alcohol tests.

24 Mr. Jamvold is requesting permission to travel to Ireland and Scotland with his family,  
25 including his fiancé and daughter. His family is taking this trip to celebrate his daughter's  
26 graduation. Mr. Jamvold has provided a travel itinerary to his probation officer, Matthew  
27 Faubert, and Mr. Faubert has no objection to this request. Mr. Faubert indicated that, because  
28 the trip involves international travel, the Court must grant permission.

1 WHEREFORE, Mr. Jamvold requests that this Court enter an order authorizing him to  
2 travel internationally from June 22, 2017, to July 6, 2017.
