MINUTE ORDER

ORDER ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE KATHLEEN M. TAFOYA

Defendant Randall Blair's "Motion to Amend Answer to Add Counterclaim" (Doc. No. 563, filed February 9, 2012) is DENIED without prejudice. The parties specifically were advised by this court during the Scheduling Conference held on January 18, 2012, that they are required to confer by email, in accordance with D.C.COLO.LCivR 7.1A, before filing any motions other than motions under Fed.
