ORDER DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCIES

28 U.S.C. § 1915 Motion and Affidavit:

- (1) xx is not submitted
- (2) is missing affidavit
- (3) xx is missing certified copy of prisoner's trust fund statement for the 6-month period immediately preceding this filing
- (4) is missing certificate showing current balance in prison account
- (5) is missing required financial information
- (6) xx is missing authorization to calculate and disburse filing fee payments
- (7) is missing an original signature by the prisoner
- (8) is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (9) names in caption do not match names in caption of complaint, petition or habeas application
