ORDER ON MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pro se Plaintiff David Orlando Noel, Sr., a prisoner at the Central State Prison in Macon, Georgia, filed a complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. (Doc. 1). After review of Plaintiff's complaint, the Court entered an Order and Recommendation on October 2, 2025 that recommended that his complaint be dismissed. (Doc. 4).
